Course Description: ¡Adelante! (Move forward!) Our "Spanish Intermediate" course is designed for learners with a solid foundation who want to elevate their communication skills. Over 6 parts (36 weeks), you'll delve into more complex grammar structures, broaden your vocabulary, and practise expressing yourself confidently in various contexts.

What will I learn?

- Part 1 (Weeks 1-6): Reviewing & expanding on intermediate grammar structures, expressing nuances of past tenses, discussing hypothetical situations.
- **Part 2 (Weeks 7-12):** The subjunctive mood in various contexts, expressing purpose & result, describing possibilities & obligations.
- Part 3 (Weeks 13-18): Discussing literature & current affairs, expressing opinions with supporting arguments, formal vs informal communication styles.
- Part 4 (Weeks 19-24): Writing formal and informal emails & letters, delivering presentations & pitches, negotiation skills.
- Part 5 (Weeks 25-30): Discussing cultural topics & social issues, expressing agreement & disagreement in a nuanced way, understanding idiomatic expressions.

- **Part 6 (Weeks 31-36):** Developing a sophisticated vocabulary for various topics, summarising & analysing complex texts, expressing yourself with clarity & precision.

How will I be assessed?

- In-depth discussions & debates on a variety of topics
- Presentations & group projects showcasing critical thinking & communication skills
- Written assignments & essays demonstrating advanced grammar & vocabulary application

Who is this course for?

This course is ideal for learners with a strong intermediate understanding of Spanish who want to achieve a higher level of fluency and express themselves confidently in academic and professional settings.
