Learn how to prototype your designs using cardboard and photogrammetry, then translate them into vector graphics for applications like T-shirt printing and laser cutting. Explore the world of cloud-based commerce, understanding tools, security concerns, and best practices. Develop your professional skills through portfolio creation, presentations, and interview preparation. By the end, you'll be ready to launch your creative journey with confidence.

What Will I Learn?

- Weeks 1-3: Design Thinking, Tinkercad introduction and advanced techniques, preparing for 3D printing.
- Weeks 4-6: Design principles, prototyping with cardboard and photogrammetry, integrating photogrammetry with Tinkercad.
- Weeks 7-9: Vector graphics conversion, applying designs to T-shirts and laser cutting.

- Portfolio development, presentations, interview preparation, and career development support.

How Will I Be Assessed?

- A combination of assignments, presentations, practical projects using Tinkercad, and a final portfolio will showcase your learned skills.

Who is this Course For?

This course is ideal for aspiring designers, artists, and creative individuals interested in exploring cloud-based design tools and turning their ideas into reality. No prior experience is necessary.

How will the course be delivered?

This is a practical course, and the sessions will include tutor-led demonstrations, learner-led group activities, instruction and repetition. These will form part of the delivery together with one-to-one support as required.

Will I need to practise outside the classroom?

You will be encouraged to review your notes between lessons to ensure maximum benefit from your course. It is always useful to practise your skills between sessions. Your tutor may encourage home learning, or independent research.

How will I know I'm making progress?

During the first session, your tutor will discuss your goals and current level in relation to the course. Based on this assessment, you will agree individual targets which you will record in your individual learning plan (ILP). You and your tutor will review your targets regularly to ensure that you are making progress; these will be written in your individual learning plan.

What will I need?

Please bring a notepad, and pen to each session. You may wish to bring a file for any handouts. A laptop with internet access is required for completion of coursework and home learning outside of the classroom.

Please note:

You need to be 19 or over to do a Skills Bootcamp. For most Skills Bootcamps, you do not need to have any previous knowledge in the subject. You just need to speak a good level of English and have a willingness to learn.

Most courses attract a subsidy from the Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA).

It is a requirement of the ESFA that you complete various forms at different stages of your course, further information is available on request. Courses are fully funded by the Government for independent learners. Part of the price of a Skills Bootcamp may be required to be funded by the employer where an employer is upskilling one of their own employees.

Courses are subject to a minimum number of enrolments and could be cancelled if recruitment is low. In some cases, an alternative class at a different location may be offered.
