Entry requirements	If you have a little knowledge, or attended the British Sign Language Beginners course, then this course is for you.
Course aims	Learn the basics of BSL and develop a wider use of vocabulary, grammar, and fundamental signing skills. Be able to construct simple sentences and conversations
How will the course be delivered?	This is a practical course and the sessions will include tutor-led demonstrations, learner-led group activities, instruction and repetition. These will form part of the delivery together with one-to-one support as required.
Will I need to study or practise outside the classroom?	It is always useful to practise your skills between sessions.
How will I know I'm making progress?	During the first session, your tutor will discuss your goals and current level in relation to the course. Based on this assessment, you will agree individual targets which you will record in your individual learning plan (ILP). You and your tutor will review your targets regularly to ensure that you are making progress; these will be written in your individual learning plan.
What will I need for the course?	Please bring a pen, notepad and a file for your hand-outs.
Progression	Look out for information regarding follow-on courses.  Consider progressing to a qualification.  There are other similar courses that you may be interested in. Please note that the fees for these vary and the eligibility for concessionary fees may be different. Learning Advisors will be happy to provide you with information of what progression is available.
